Sutton Park School is proud to announce a number of music scholarships will be available through the Young Musician Competition. The school wants to build on its excellent achievements in music performance and this is an opportunity for musicians interested in combining intensive opportunities to practice with mainstream schooling. Applicants who have performed at the Prize Winner's Concert can apply for entry to the school through normal school admissions procedures. The scholarship application will be taken in the context of the school's deadlines regarding admissions. This especially applies in relation to our 1st Year Cohort.

In order to be safe for this event, all candidates will be given individual appointments for their performance in the school with no audience permitted. The event will take place in the Atrium which is a large space with superior ventilation. The adjudicator will be at least 6 metres away from the performers and there will be no groups performing this year. Candidates will remain in the car park at the front of the building.

Professor Gerard Gillen

The adjudicator for this year's competition will be internationally recognised educationalist, world class organist and musician, Professor Gerard Gillen. Professor Gillen has given recitals in prestigious international venues such as the Royal Festival Hall, Mc Ewan Hall, Edinburgh and in cathedrals including Pittsburg, Salt Lake City, San Francisco, Canterbury, Notre Dame, Paris, Vienna, Salzburg, Regensburg, Freiburg, Hamburg, Haarlem, Brussels Antwerp, Bruges, Copenhagen, Madrid and Tallinn.

1. Competitions are open to students who reside on the **North side of Dublin** or attending a north side music teacher
2. **Candidates play one piece** or movement of their own choice **not exceeding five minutes** duration.
3. Please note 'under 10' means 'aged 10 and under'. (The same applies in all categories)
4. Candidates must qualify in age **on 8th May 2021**
5. An original copy of the music must be provided for the adjudicator on the day of competition.
6. Candidates must register in the office thirty minutes before their competition is due to begin.
7. The closing date for receipt of music entries is **Friday 23rd April**
8. The decision of the adjudicator is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
9. Previous first prize winners may not compete in the same category again.
10. Accompanist can only be provided if a hard copy of the music comes in with the entry. Digital transfer not accepted.
